Important Upcoming Dates:



- March 15th Yearly invoices go out to all residents. Homeowner dues are due on or before April 15th. Please note that membership must be paid prior to enjoying our pool facility. (Late fee applies once 30 days past due)
- April 15 HOA payments are due
- April 11th <u>The annual homeowner's association meeting is at 7:00 p.m.</u> in the parking lot under the basketball goals/next to the playground. <u>We need you!!</u> <u>Please come out and attend. This year all board positions are up for Election.</u> Our rainout date will be April 25th at 7 p.m. If you have not paid your Annual Membership dues, you can pay at the meeting. (bring a chair)
- May 18th Pool Opening Day. KEYS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED THAT DAY 9:00-11:00am
- Sept 15th Pool Closes for the season!
- October 31st Halloween party! (We need 2 families to volunteer to help organize the event for the evening of Halloween. (a) Contact a board member if interested in helping.

Security Cameras - Cameras have been installed at the Pool/Tennis court areas and parking lots! This is to help insure safety of our neighborhood and facilities.

<u>ALERT!!</u> The outdoor basketball/tennis facilities <u>close</u> at sunset and there is no reason for anyone to be there after that time. We are asking for all neighbors to be aware and make our youth aware of these rules. The Law Enforcement should be notified if this rule is not abided, and not the HOA. Our facility is there for HOMEOWNER'S to enjoy, and should be respected as such. Anyone who does not follow the association rules will be asked to leave.

PLAYGROUND AREA - For our children's safety, the playground area is to be utilized by children under the age of 12. This equipment is not designed to accommodate older children.

<u>News-</u> The Annual HOA Dues have slightly increased this year to \$95.00 to help cover the increasing cost of upkeep to the facilities. The Swim dues at this time will remain the same at \$275.00. *(Please understand that the association counts on your funds to help offset the expenses yearly.) *Notices will be sent with late fees if not paid on time.
